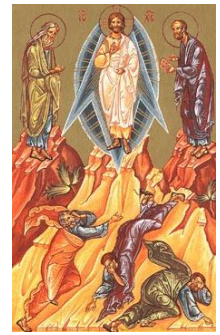




St. Olympia Orthodox Church
